GDi Field Map is a simple and easy to learn tool for inspectors, field engineers, supervisors, environmental researchers and other employees who need their organizational data to be reviewed and updated in the field.

Which GDi Field Map edition to use?

GDi Field Map provides tools to manage data, review data updates, manage bookmarks, zoom to GPS location and attach photos. There are two editions available to accommodate different customers' requirements, GDi Field Map Server and GDi Field Map Desktop. Both editions include Android application for the simple and effective editing of your own map that you have prepared in ArcMap.

GDi Field Map Server enables you to download data and send the changes back directly from the field whenever required. Data exchange is implemented via your ArcGIS for Server or ArcGIS Online where you published your map. Data creation and editing can be done in offline mode, without internet connection.

GDi Field Map Desktop is a package that includes Android Application and ArcMap add-ins tools. Data exchange is implemented as file transfer between the ArcMap computer and Android device and not available in the field. Field Map Desktop implements an additional option, an intermediate import step, that allows preview and correction of field data in ArcMap before updating the main geodatabase. The solution does not require ArcGIS for Server or ArcGIS Online.

GDi Field Map demo is available in main application stores such as Amazon and Google Playstore. Free GDi Field Map demo does not require any ArcGIS software and has limited functionalities.
